Today every use of force incident is scrutinized frame by frame on a video and judged by untrained individuals creating distrust and false narratives. The use of force analysis, investigation, and training is a complex continually evolving issue. This 2-day training session is designed for Police Leaders who, review, report, instructor investigates police use of force incidents. The training will examine the most recent and up to date issues that **specifically impact Leaders, IA investigators, and trainers concerning police use of force incidents**.
