INSTRUCTOR: Lt. Kevin Dillon (Whethersfield, CT Police Department, Retired) is a twenty-six year veteran law enforcement officer, SWAT Commander, internationally recognized expert on combatives instructor and speaker. He is the founder and developer of the L.O.C.K.U.P.* Police Training System now presently instructed in over 18 states and 5 countries. He has appeared on CNN, NPR, Police Magazine.com, PoliceOne Academy Expert and Contributor for PoliceOne.com. Lt. Dillon will discuss current issues and how to use **Strategies and Tactics** for law enforcement and civilian personnel response to human aggression. Recent research and incidents will be discussed and how to apply the science and research to enhance tactics and response.
