COURSE DESCRIPTION: Through demonstrations, role plays, and practical scenario applications this course is designed to develop instructors in the LOCKUP Arrest and Control System. Legal aspects of use of force and physical applications pertaining to law enforcement/corrections arrest and control will be discussed. A strong emphasis on immediate physical control tactics and techniques that are a direct, proportionate, and measured response to all levels of resistance and aggression in multiple environments and settings will be practiced. Additionally, teaching methodologies needed to instruct physical applications and test students for competency will be shared.

Some training on wet surfaces outdoors will be included. A towel and extra change of clothing is recommended.

Seating priority goes to officers of Osceola County. **This class is limited to 24 participants.**

REGISTER - Officers interested in attending must contact their agency training division for approval. A signed agency training authorization form or CJAO 15A registration form must be completed and emailed or faxed to the Academy by authorized training personnel prior to the start of class. Not a technique-based training system but emphasis on the actual collection of data on use of force incidents, and detailed reporting to determine the effectiveness and needs assessments of officers on the street.
