COURSE DESCRIPTION: Through demonstrations, role plays, and practical scenario applications this course is designed to develop officer strategy and awareness in the LOCKUP Ground Control and Edged Weapon Instructor principals and concepts. A strong emphasis on immediate physical control tactics and techniques that are a direct, proportionate, and measured response to all levels of aggression in various environments and low light settings will be included. The severity of an edged weapon encounter will be demonstrated using slabs of steak along with knife encounter videos. Use of force and physical applications when dealing with law enforcement/corrections combative subjects will be the core outcome.

Seating priority goes to officers of Osceola County. **This class is limited to 24 participants.**

REGISTER - Officers interested in attending must contact their agency training division for approval. A signed agency training authorization form or CJA0 15A registration form must be completed and emailed or faxed to the Academy by authorized training personnel prior to the start of class.
